This garden is a living museum featuring one of the most diverse plant collections in the United States. Established in 1890, the Garden's 34 acres contain over 12,000 different kinds of plants from all over the world arranged by region. The New World Desert and indoor succulent collections include many specimens from South America. There are ferns, carnivorous, and tropical plants housed in greenhouses, Chinese medicinal herb gardens, a redwood grove, a garden shop, and much more!
